





Construction Update: Project Completion Postponed to Late January 2025 Due to Unforeseen Utility Conflicts

IMPORTANT: Due to several unforeseen conflicts with utilities, the completion date for this project has been postponed to <u>late</u> <u>January 2025</u>.

Traffic Impacts

The following traffic impacts remain in place:

- The Alameda Arroyo Trail crossing remains closed.
- Westbound US 70/North Main Street has one lane open from Elks Drive to south of the Alameda Arroyo Bridge, then two lanes open to Spitz Ave.
- Eastbound US 70/Main Street has two lanes open from N. Solano Drive to N. Triviz Drive.
- Access will be maintained to all businesses and residences during construction.

The speed limit is reduced to <u>35 miles per hour</u> throughout the construction zone. Motorists are encouraged to use extra caution in the construction zone, obey lower posted speed limits and allow extra time to reach their destinations.

Regular work hours are **Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.,** although the contractor may work longer hours or on weekends if needed.

The project is expected to be completed late January 2025.
